FSGC Requirements:

- Separate acceptance by Graduate School for pursuit of FSGC.*
- 12 hours of course work, of which 9 hours must be at the 300/5000/6000 level or above; with prior approval, a maximum of one 200/4000 level course may be applied to the Certificate
- **Required coursework:** each student must take one feminist theory course and one feminist pedagogy course, unless waived by the director or WGSS FSGC advisor
- No more than one Women's, Gender, & Sexuality Studies 390/5390 course may be applied to the certificate
- Except for WGSS courses, no more than two classes (6 hours) can be taken from any one department or faculty member- this ensures the interdisciplinarity of this certificate
